University of Dohuk

University of Dohuk was founded on **October 31, 1992** when Baghdad regime (the oppressive reign of Ba'ath Party) issued a decree prevents the Kurdish high school graduates from admission in to the Iraqi universities. At that time, the capacity of Salahaddin University in Erbil couldn't cover the total number of Dohuk students to sustain their study in addition to its students. Kurdistan region government issued a decree to establish University of Dohuk. At the beginning of its establishment, it included two colleges, college of medicine and college of agriculture. The total number of the students for that year was **48** in the medical college and **166** in the college of Agriculture.

Colleges of the University

University of Dohuk includes **ten** colleges:

College of Medicine

This college was established in **1992**. The total number of its students is **(288)**. Azadi Hospital is considered as an educational hospital within the college site serves the college's Clinical studies. The college comprises main branches; Medicine and Community Medicine, Surgery, Anatomy and Embryology, Physiology and

Pharmacology, Gynecology and Obstetrics, Chemistry, Physics and Computer

College of Agriculture

College of Agriculture was founded in **1992**. It offers variety of agricultural and non-agricultural terms. The college comprises four departments, Horticulture, Forestry, Animal Production and Soil and Water. The total number of its students **(463)**

College of Jurisprudence and Islamic studies

The college was founded in **1992**. it comprised two departments; Jurisprudence and Islamic studies. Admission in this college ceased in **2001-2002**. Now it includes the students of the fourth stage in both mentioned departments in addition to the third periodic of the Master degree.

College of Engineering

The college was founded in **1994**. The total number of students is **(329)** within two departments; Department of Civil Engineering and Department of Water Resources Engineering.

College of Arts

College of Arts was founded in **1994**. The total number of the students is **(482)** distributed among three main departments; Kurdish, English, and History departments. A department of English for Evening study was established in **2002-2003** and the total of its students is **113**

College of Administration and Economics

The department of economic was founded in **1995**. It was administratively affiliated to the college of Arts until the college of Administration and Economics was founded in **1997**. In **1998** a department of Business Management was founded and a department of Financial and Bank Sciences in **2004**. The newly department of Accounting was founded in **2004** to commence students admission in **2005**. The number of its students will approach to **(800)** students in **2005**

College of Science (Presently College of Education)

The college was established in **1997** and included two departments; Physics and Mathematics. Since **2002-2003** the college has been modified to **College of Education** to overcome the deficiency in the teaching staff of schools in Dohuk city for the next ten years. The college comprises nine departments; Computer Sciences Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, English Language, Kurdish Language, Arabic Language and Department of History. The total of its students is **(765)**.

College of Veterinary Medicine

The college was established in **1998** and the total number of its students is **(148)**. The college comprises three main branches; Department of Medicine and Prophylactic, and department of Surgery and Obstetrics Medicine.

College of Basic Education

It was known as **Teachers Department**, a part of College of Education, and then separated to become **College of Basic Education** in **2003**. The total of its students is **(341)**

College of Law and Politics

This college includes the department of Law only and it was opened in **1997** within the college of Administration and Economics. In **1999**, the department was affiliated to the college on its establishment. The total number of its students now is **(199)**.

Sport Union

The University Sports Union was established in **1995**, The Union offers many activities and sports on different levels throughout the year.

Scientific and Cultural Centers

There are several educational and cultural centers and bureaus in Dohuk University. Some of them are linked to University presidency office; others are linked to the colleges; Engineering consultant Bureau, Kurdish Studies Centers, computer and Internet Center, Agriculture Consultant Bureau, Applied Agriculture Production Center, Cultural Social Center, Islamic studies press, phone bureau for Islamic college, apartments and buildings of Islamic college. An administration council representing the highest academic and administrative supervision in the center runs these centers.
